Loss Assessment Report

Overview

This Executive Summary presents a concise overview of the Loss Assessment conducted for ABC Manufacturing Facility following the water ingress incident on 10 May 2024. The evaluation covered damage to buildings, machinery, and inventory, as well as operational and financial impacts resulting from the event.

Incident Description

On the evening of 10 May 2024, a severe thunderstorm resulted in flooding of the main production hall, causing significant water damage to infrastructure, production equipment, and raw material stockpiles. Immediate containment and safety measures were carried out by on-site personnel.
