Important Notes about Compressed JPEG Invoice Format:

- JPEG is a lossy image compression format, suitable for digital archiving where text clarity is required but not intended for direct data extraction.
- Invoices stored in JPEG are not machine-readable; text cannot be automatically parsed without OCR technology.
- Compression settings should balance file size and legibility—excessive compression may result in unreadable text and loss of legal validity.
- For regulatory or audit purposes, preserve the original generated document alongside the JPEG image when possible.
- Ensure that the JPEG invoice image includes all essential invoice fields (seller/buyer details, line items, total, date, etc.) and signatures if required.
