## Purpose

The purpose of this MoU is to define the mutual understandings regarding the financial contribution, project implementation, and reporting responsibilities for the joint research and development project titled "Next-Gen Clean Energy Solutions".

## Roles and Responsibilities

- **First Party** shall execute and manage the project as per the Work Plan.
- **Second Party** will provide funding as per the agreed disbursement schedule.

## Funding and Disbursement

- The total funding for the project is USD 500,000.
- Funding will be transferred in three tranches, subject to milestone completion and project deliverable review.
- Financial reports and expenditure breakdowns will be submitted within 30 days following each tranche.

## Term and Termination

- This MoU is effective from 1 July 2024 to 30 June 2025.
- Any party may terminate this MoU upon 30 days written notice, subject to the settlement of outstanding obligations.
