

Proof of Identity Document List for Individual PAN Application

Acceptable Proof of Identity (Any one of the following):

1. Elector's photo identity card
2. Passport
3. Driving license
4. Aadhaar Card issued by the Unique Identification Authority of India
5. Ration card having photograph of the applicant
6. Arm's license
7. Photo identity card issued by the Central Government or State Government or Public Sector Undertaking
8. Pensioner card having photograph of the applicant
9. Central Government Health Scheme Card or Ex-servicemen Contributory Health Scheme photo card
10. Certificate of identity in original signed by a Member of Parliament or Member of Legislative Assembly or Municipal Councilor or a Gazetted Officer (in prescribed format)
11. Bank certificate in original on letter head from the branch (along with attested photograph and bank account number) stating that the applicant maintains an account (in prescribed format)

Important Notes

- All documents must be legible and in original or properly attested copies as required.
- The name on the identity proof must exactly match the name to be printed on the PAN card.
- Expired and/or mutilated documents will not be accepted.
- Additional documents may be required if there are discrepancies or at the discretion of the issuing authority.
