Declaration under section 197A(1C) of the Income-tax Act, 1961

Declaration to be made by an individual who is of the age of sixty years or more claiming certain receipts without deduction of tax.

Important Notes:

- Form 15H is to be used by individuals above 60 years of age (senior citizens).
- It is a self-declaration so that no TDS is deducted on certain incomes like bank interest if estimated total income is below the taxable limit.

- The PAN must be mandatorily quoted; else, the form is invalid.
- False declaration may invite penal consequences under the Income Tax Act.
- Keep a copy of this form for your records before submitting to the deductor.
