


Sample Statistical Chart Formats

1. Bar Chart

Displays categorical data with rectangular bars, commonly used to compare quantities across categories.



2. Pie Chart

Shows proportional data as slices of a circle. Useful for depicting part-to-whole relationships.

■ Category A (40%) ■ Category B (30%) ■ Category C (30%)

3. Statistical Table

Tabular format to present exact data values. Useful for reporting detailed statistics.

Group	Count	Mean	Std Dev
A	40	68.0	7.2
B	30	72.5	6.5
C	30	64.9	8.1

Important Notes:

- Select chart formats based on the data type and the message to convey.
- Ensure all axes, labels, and legends are clear and easy to read.
- Statistical tables should present raw numbers with summary statistics when possible.
- Charts should include data sources and units where applicable.
