General Weather Synopsis

The region is currently under the influence of a mild southwest monsoon. Scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms are expected mainly in the afternoon and evening. Temperatures will remain near average for this time of year with moderate humidity levels. Winds are expected to be light to moderate, predominantly from the southwest.
