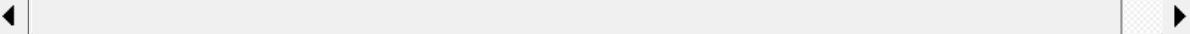


Sample Invoice CSV: Tax and Discount Representation

CSV Sample

InvoiceNo,Date,Customer,Item,Quantity,UnitPrice,Discount,TaxRate,TaxAmount,LineTotal
INV001,2024-06-28,Acme Corp,Widget-A,2,50.00,10.00,5,4.00,94.00

Column Description

InvoiceNo	= Invoice number
Date	= Invoice date (YYYY-MM-DD)
Customer	= Customer name
Item	= Item or product name
Quantity	= Number of units
UnitPrice	= Price per unit (before discount/tax)
Discount	= Discount applied per line (currency)
TaxRate	= Tax rate (%) applied to taxable amount
TaxAmount	= Tax calculated per line (currency)
LineTotal	= Total amount for the line (after discount, plus tax)

Important Notes

- Discount is applied before tax calculation per invoice line.
- TaxAmount is calculated after discount is subtracted from UnitPrice \times Quantity.
- LineTotal = (Quantity \times UnitPrice - Discount) + TaxAmount.
- Ensure all numbers are in consistent decimal format (e.g., 2 decimals).
- Multiple items on one invoice should have the same InvoiceNo but different lines.
- Always check local tax laws for specific representation requirements.
