Sample CSV Data

Important Notes

- The first row (header) defines the field names and structure for the EDI CSV document.
- Each subsequent row represents a line item for the invoice; header details repeat on each line.
- Values must be separated by commas and should follow consistent formatting and data types as agreed by both parties.
- This type of format simplifies EDI integration but requires strict structure validation on both sender and receiver sides.
- Additional or custom fields can be added as required by trading partners.
- All numeric values (like `UnitPrice` , `LineTotal` , `TaxAmount`) should use period (`.`) as the decimal separator.
