

Insurance Policy Number Format

Format Structure

The insurance policy number is a unique identifier assigned to an individual insurance policy. Its format may vary based on the insurance company and product type. Below is a common sample structure:

ABC-2024-12345678-XX

- **ABC** — Company/Product Code (letters)
- **2024** — Year of Issue (digits)
- **12345678** — Sequential Policy Number (digits)
- **XX** — Suffix/Check digits (letters or numbers)

- HCL-2021-11223344-ZZ
- MED-2022-25987463-B5
