This General Liability Waiver Agreement ("Agreement") is executed on

1. Acknowledgment of Risk

I, the undersigned, acknowledge that participation in activities organized by the Released Party carries certain inherent risks that cannot be eliminated regardless of the care taken to avoid injuries.

2. Waiver and Release

In consideration for being permitted to participate in such activities, I hereby voluntarily, fully, and forever waive, release, and discharge the Released Party, its officers, employees, and agents from any and all claims, demands, rights, or causes of action arising from loss, injury, or damages, including death, that may arise out of or relate to my participation, whether caused by negligence or otherwise to the fullest extent permitted by law.

3. Indemnification

I agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Released Party against any and all claims, damages, liabilities, and expenses, including attorney's fees, incurred as a result of my participation in the activities.

4. Medical Treatment

I give permission to the Released Party to obtain emergency medical treatment on my behalf if deemed necessary. I understand that I am responsible for all related costs.

5. Governing Law

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the applicable jurisdiction where the activities take place.
