Important Notes:

- Dates are formatted as **YYYY-MM-DD** (ISO 8601 standard) for consistency and compatibility.
- Amounts and numbers use a **period (.) as decimal separator**, with no thousands separator.
- Tax rates are represented in **decimal format** (e.g., 0.10 for 10%).
- Ensure all values are properly quoted if using commas inside text fields.
- CSV files should use UTF-8 encoding for best compatibility.
