

2. Objectives

The objectives section states what the research aims to achieve. Objectives should be concise, specific, and clearly measurable. Below is a sample format for the Objectives section in a research proposal statement:

1. **General Objective:**

To investigate the impact of online learning platforms on students' academic performance in secondary schools.

2. **Specific Objectives:**

- To examine the frequency and manner of online platform usage among secondary school students.
- To analyze the correlation between online learning engagement and students' academic results.
- To assess student and teacher perceptions of online learning effectiveness.
- To identify challenges faced by students in utilizing online learning platforms.

Important Notes

- Objectives must be clear, focused, and aligned with the problem statement.
- Start with a broad general objective, followed by several specific objectives.
- Each specific objective should be realistic and achievable within the project's scope.
- Avoid vague objectives; make them measurable wherever possible.
- Well-defined objectives guide the entire research process and methodology.
