

Summary of Key Findings

Compliance Report

Background

This compliance report was conducted to assess the organization's adherence to regulatory requirements and internal policies for the reporting period of January to June 2024.

Key Findings

- Policy Adherence:** The majority of business units demonstrated strong adherence to corporate compliance policies, with a compliance rate of 94%.
- Training and Awareness:** 96% of employees completed mandatory compliance training within the specified timeframe.
- Documentation:** Some gaps were noted in the documentation of risk assessments, particularly within the procurement department.
- Incident Reporting:** Four minor compliance incidents were reported, all of which were resolved promptly in line with protocol.

Recommendations

- Continue providing periodic refresher compliance training to all staff.
